





- Best time: November to April, with December, January and February are the months with most pleasant temperature.

Central: Hue and Hoi An


- Rainy season: September to December

An official transport in Vietnam is MOTORBIKE. There about 40 million motos for a population of 90 million people. And prepare yourself to see almost everything on them: 1,2,3,4 or 5 people at the same time, children, dogs, cages, refrigerators, bags,... They can carry everything on only one motor.

And to cross the street, the motto is KEEP GOING! just go! They will deviate from you! One of the most tipical scenes of Vietnam is the Vietnamese hats. Every Vietnamese person uses it, either on the streets or in parks. They use it to protect themselves from the sun

Is impossible to go to Vietnam and come back without its traditional hat.

The traditional Vietnamese dress for women,"Ao dai", consists of a long robe (glued to the body) over pantalona style pants.

The specialty of the "Ao dai" is that it is a tight-fitting dress which magnifies the beautiful curves of a woman's body. The slits on both sides up to the waist create a charming and unique cut that is classically flattering. Today, designers have created many new styles of 'Ao dai', diversifying this costume.



HANOI - THE CAPITAL CITY



Hoan Kiem Lake: A lake that is located in the center of the city, a great place to take a walk and admire the Vietnamese culture.



HOI AN










Museum of the history of the city "Sa Huynh":Learn about the history of Hoi An ancient city from the 2nd century to the 15th century Silk shops: Hoi An is also popular for the silk that it produces and there are dozens of shops that offer this kind fabric to customers. In general, the sellers will show their guest the method of production (from the birth of the animal to the silk production and when the silk is completed).

Japanese Covered Bridge: a beautiful example of the Japanese arquitecture. At one end of the bridge, there is a dog sculpture and at the other end, there is a monkey sculpture. These two animals are there sacred symbols in Japanese culture.

Phuc Kien temple: a perfect example of the Chinese arquitecture. The temple is a religiousrelic. It is the largest auditorium and exhibits rich architectural and artistic features.





HO CHI MINH CITY

Ho Chi Minh City is located in the South of Vietnam. Being considered the largest city of the country (with approx. 8 million people), it's the financial centre of Vietnam, very cosmopolitan, bustling and most westernized city of Vietnam. Before officially named Ho Chi Minh City, the city was once called Saigon. the name was changed in 1976 in tribute to the grand leader and hero of Vietnam: Ho Chi Minh, who is considered largely respon- sible for Vietnam becoming independent from France. Ho Chi Minh City is full of tall buildings, boulevards, design stores, ex- celent restaurants, bars and many interesting attractions to explore!

Reunification Palace

Formerly known as Independence Palace, has always stayed in the mind of many generations of not only Vietnamese people but also foreigners. It is known as the famous historical witness which passed through the two fierce wars against the French and American colonists. As Vietnam was split into North Vietnam and South Vietnam, the building served as presidential home and workplace. Today, the palace is remembered vividly as a marked end to the war.

War remnants museum

One of the main places to visit in Ho Chi Minh city. This museum was inaugurated in 1975. The brutality of the conflict between United States and Vietnam is shown in detail there.

Notre Dame Catedral

This Catholic church was constructed in 1877 by the French (with materials imported from France).

Cu Chi Tunnels

Perhaps one of the most remarkable attractions. It's a fantastic place where the creativity of the Vietnamese people is shown. Cu Chi is a dictrict located around 40km from Ho Chi Minh City (1h30' by car). There are more than 240km of underground tunnels which reach up to 20m deep and could house thousands of people for many months.

Opera House

One of the landmarks of the city, the Opera House was designed by a French arquitect, Eugene Ferret in 1897. From 1955 to 1897 it was used as the Assembly of the Government of the South of Vietnam, and later it became a theater.


Post Office

This building was designed by the famous French arquitect / engineer Gustave Eiffel) and was constructed in 1886

CANBODIA HISTORY OF CAMBODIA

Through the smile of the Cambodian peope, many people do not know the sad history of the country in the Khmer Rouge time (happened in the middle of the 20th century, between 1975 and 1979).

Cambodia was a French colony from 1863 to 1953. When the invasion was over, the new government of Cambodia wanted to create a country from scratch, eliminating everything that existed before. Because of that, so came the execution program (Khmer Rouge) that killed everyone who had any kinds of connection with the previous government. After that, people were killed for even more trivial reasons, for example, intellectual people.

The Khmer Rouge lasted until 1979, when it was eliminated by Vietnam. The number of victims is not exact. Some studies estimate around 3 million death, while others 1,5 million,... Whatever the number is, this is the largest massacre that has existed in proportion to the population of a country.

The constitutional monarchy was restored only in 1993. Now the King is Norodom Sihamoni and the Prime Minister is Hun Sen.




ANGKOR WAT

- Angkor Wat is the largest religious temple of the world and one of the most preserved temples of Cambodia.
- It is recommended visitting Angkor Wat at sunset.
- This temple was constructed in the 12th century and was dedicated to the hindu god Vishnu.
- This temple complex covers 81 hectares and its 5 famous towers are part of the national flag of cambodia.

- •Bayon with its 54 towers of enigmatic smiley faces have the four faces of Avalokiteshvara



TA PROHM

- •The temple was a monastery built by Jayavarman VII for his mother's residence. In the middle of the jungle, you climb the stone structures and be amazed by the giant trees that reach the top of the temple.

It's the entrance to the Angkor region. In this city, there are museums, traditional dance show Apsara,


















THAILAND KNOW MORE



















Sathorn / Silom: The busiest area in Bangkok, near the main attactions.
