CAMBODIA VISA EXEMPTION

Regular passport holders from the 8 countries listed below do not need a tourist visa for Cambodia

Exemption list:

- Visitors from the following countries are eligible for a 14-day stay without a visa: Myanmar, Thailand
- Visitors from the following countries are eligible for a 15-day stay without a visa: Seychelles
- Visitors from the following countries are eligible for a 30-day stay without a visa: Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Vietnam

Special note:

Nationals of these countries can enter Cambodia without a visa for a specific period, which varies depending on the country. However, it is important to note that visa exemptions are subject to change, so it is always advisable to check with the nearest Cambodian embassy or consulate before travel.



CAMBODIA E-VISA

E-visa is granted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation to enable 54 countries to apply for a visa online. **The list includes:**

Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, China, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, India, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Mexico, Monaco, Mongolia, Montenegro, Netherlands, New Zealand, North Macedonia, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russian, Federation, San Marino, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom, United States of America, Vatican City

Cambodia e-visa requirements:

- A passport is valid for at least six months beyond the duration of your stay in Cambodia.
- A recent passport-sized photo in digital format that meets the specified requirements.
- A valid email address to receive the e-visa approval letter.
- A means of paying the e-visa fee, such as a credit or debit card.
- E-visa fee of USD 36 (non-refundable)

Processing time:

The processing time for a Cambodian e-visa is typically **between 1 and 3 business** days. However, it can take up to a week or more during peak travel season or if there are issues with the application. It is recommended to apply at least a week in advance of your intended travel date to allow for any unforeseen delays.



CAMBODIA E-ARRIVAL

Cambodia requires travelers to complete a Customs and Immigration form before or upon arrival in the country. In this digital era, Cambodia is transitioning to an electronic form called the **Cambodia E-Arrival**, which visitors can complete before arrival via the app/website, or by scanning a QR code at the airport of departure.

- The Cambodia e-Arrival is currently available only for arrivals at: **Siem Reap Angkor International Airport, Phnom Penh Techo International Airport, and Sihanoukville International Airport**. For land border crossings, traditional paper forms will be used.
- The Cambodia e-Arrival form can be completed via the official website <https://arrival.gov.kh/> or via the QR codes available at the airports upon arrival.
- The E-form must be filled out **within 7 days before arrival or on arrival at the airport** (however, we strongly recommend completing it in advance to avoid waiting time at the airport).



CAMBODIA VISA ON ARRIVAL

The visa on arrival (VOA) is only available for certain nationalities, and it may be subject to change. It is always a good idea to check with the Cambodian embassy or consulate in your country before traveling to Vietnam to confirm the latest visa requirements.

Please follow the below steps:

Step 1: Fill out the Cambodia visa application form. You can obtain the form upon arrival in Cambodia, or you can download it from the Cambodian Embassy website and fill it out in advance.

Step 2: Provide a passport-sized photo: You will need to provide a recent passport-sized photo along with your application.

Step 3: Pay the visa fee of USD 30

Step 4: Wait for the processing.

Important note

- Make sure that the passport has at least 6 months of validity from the entry date ahead.
- The Visa on Arrival works if travelers enter Cambodia via Phnom Penh International Airport & Siem Reap International Airport.
- You need to prepare some cash (US dollars or Cambodian riel) for the stamping fee since no credit cards are accepted.
- Your visa will be processed by immigration officials upon arrival in Cambodia. The processing time may vary, so be prepared to wait.
- Once processed, Visa service cannot be canceled, so we require you to make full payment in advance, and it is non-refundable.



CAMBODIA V-PASS

As of 1 January 2026, Cambodia will introduce the V-Pass, a digital immigration record that replaces traditional passport stamps. No physical stamp or QR sticker will be placed in passports.

Who must apply

All international travelers arriving at:

- Phnom Penh Techo International Airport (KTI)
- Siem Reap Angkor International Airport (SAI)
- Sihanoukville International Airport (KOS)
- Sihanoukville International Pier

Process on arrival

- Travelers must complete the Cambodia e-Arrival Card before or upon arrival and provide a valid email address.
- At immigration, passports and e-Arrival details are checked.
- Once approved, the V-Pass QR code is automatically sent to the traveler's email.



Airport service notes

- Standalone e-Arrival assistance is no longer available.
- Travelers must purchase e-Arrival + Fast Track services together (visa fee optional).
- V-Pass service fee: USD 2 per person.
